CALL TO ORDER/INVOCATION

The meeting was called to order by Sheriff Scott. The welcome was given by Supervisor Horton with invocation given by Supervisor R. B. Davis.

Supervisor Deanes moved to authorize and approve to renew the Emergency Declaration and Proclamation declared on the lighting strike to the 911 Building located on Broad Street on August 2, 2022.

AUTHORIZE AND APPROVE THE CHANCERY CLERK TO OBTAIN QUOTES FROM BANKS ON SHORT TERM NOTES TO COVER THE PURCHASE OF THE NEW REPLACEMENT 911 COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT PENDING INSURANCE PROCEEDS ARE RECEIVED TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY

Chancery Clerk, Amy Berry, stated she felt it best to issued short term notes in the amount of \$365,000 to cover the purchase of the replacement communication equipment for 911. Some of the equipment was covered under warranty. However, for the equipment not covered under warranty, this plan will work. The note money will be the funds utilized to pay for the initial purchase. After the County purchases the equipment, my staff will send to the insurance company all purchase documents (requisitions, purchase orders, receiving reports, etc.) invoice, and front and back copy of the check showing proof of payment where the County has paid for the equipment. Once the insurance company receives this paperwork, it will take them 14-25 days to process reimbursement to the County for the insurance proceeds. When the County receives, the Insurance proceeds, we can utilize those funds to pay the short term note off. Berry did acknowledge there might be a shortfall. The insurance company will only reimburses actual cash value of the item not the original book value or purchase price of the item. Hopefully, this shortfall amount will not be material.

Supervisor Deanes moved to authorize and approve the Chancery Clerk to obtain quotes from banks to issue short term notes in the amount of \$365,000 to cover the purchase of the replacement equipment needed for 911.

The motion was seconded by Supervisor Chandler.

**RESOLUTION REGARDING THE EXPENDITURE OF LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS
RECEIVED BY CLAY COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI THROUGH THE
AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT**

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, by Proclamation 9994, the President of the United States declared a national emergency concerning the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic continues to cause significant health risks to the public and the safety of the United States of America;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic continues to cause significant economic hardships on individuals, cities, counties, states and territories within the United States of America;

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the Presidents of the United States signed into law the American Rescue Plant Act, which is a \$1.9 Trillion economic stimulus bill with the state purpose of expediting the country's economic and health recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic and the ongoing recession;

WHEREAS, Section 9901 of the American Rescue Plan Act amended Title VI of the Social Security Act to add Sections 602(c)(1)(A) and 603(c)(1)(A), establishing the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, which are intended to provide support to state, local, and tribal governments in responding to the impacts COVID-19 and their efforts to contain COVID-19 in their communities, residents and businesses;

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2021, the United States Department of Treasury produced an Interim Rule providing guidance on the purpose, permissible uses and reporting of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds;

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2021, the United States Department of Treasury produced a Final Rule in some instances modifying various provisions of the Interim Rule regarding State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds.

WHEREAS, Clay County, in keeping with the Final Rule associated with the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund was authorized and elected to categorize all of its funds as lost revenue.

WHEREAS, all of Clay County's allotment(s) of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds have been maintained separate and distinct from all other general or special county funds.

WHEREAS, the Clay County Board of Supervisors wishes to expend a portion of its State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund appropriations to provide incentive pay to Clay County employees in a manner wholly consistent with stated purposes, adhering to the specific guidance provided by the United States Department of Treasury, and limitations placed on the County by applicable constitutional and statutory provisions.

WHEREAS, An Opinion issued by the Office of the Mississippi Attorney General dated November 10, 2021, provides that "A county may only expend county funds for incentive pay,

including hazard pay, when such incentives are contracted for prior to the date when services are to be performed.”

WHEREAS, Mississippi law prohibits incentive pay from being classified as “earned compensation” and thereby precludes incentive pay from being reported to the Mississippi Employees’ Retirement System (“PERS”) as income for retirement purposes.

WHEREAS, the Clay County Board of Supervisors, during a meeting held on Tuesday, September 6th, 2022, by official motion, declared its intent to provide a one time payment of \$1,000.00 to eligible full-time County employees and a one time payment of \$500.00 to each eligible part-time County employee from its State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund appropriations as incentive pay on or about September 30, 2022, for prospective work that must be performed between September 15, 2022, and September 30, 2022.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, that Clay County, Mississippi, will, in administering incentive pay to County employees, adhere to all applicable U.S. Treasury, ARPA SLFRF, State Constitution and State statutory guidelines.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Clay County adopts the following definitions and provisions for administering this one time payment:

- 1) An eligible employee is, for purposes of this incentive pay resolution, defined as any current part-time or full-time employee of Clay County, Mississippi, performing work within the course and scope of his or her employment for Clay County after September 15, 2022, through the date of payment of Clay County’s incentive or hazard pay program, based on the County’s existing employment policies, as of the date of this resolution.
- 2) The incentive pay provided through this action will be one time, non-recurring pay in exchange for future services to be performed by eligible employees of Clay County as provided herein.
- 3) Eligible employees will enter into a separate contractual agreement with Clay County prior to the pay period in which work will be performed.
- 4) County law enforcement officers, who have received incentive or hazard pay from State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds issued by or through the Mississippi Department of Public Safety, are expressly excluded as eligible County employees for the purposes of Clay County’s incentive pay program.

The details of this agreement are contained in the “Supplemental Contract”, Exhibit A.

On the motion of Supervisor Davis, which was duly seconded by Supervisor Dearies, the foregoing Resolution was called to a vote and ADOPTED on the 6th day of September, 2022, by the Clay County Board of Supervisors.



RECITALS

A. In March 2020 the President of the United States declared a national emergency concerning the Coronavirus disease of 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic;

B. COVID-19 and its variants continue to impact and cause significant health risks to the public and safety of Clay County, Mississippi (the "County"), its citizens and employees;

C. The Board of Supervisors of Clay County (the "Board") recognizes that because of the pandemic, County employees have worked and will continue to work in hazardous environments under difficult circumstances;

D. The Board desires to utilize a portion of local fiscal recovery funds granted to the County under the "American Rescue Plan Act" for the support of local governments, to incentivize employees to continue to work during the remainder of the pandemic, by providing a one-time, non-recurring benefit as hazard or incentive pay to County employees who will continue to work in unsafe conditions and difficult circumstances caused by COVID-19 and its variants;

E. This one-time, non-recurring incentive payment set out below is for personal services performed by employees from and after the date of this Contract and not for past services performed.

NOW, THEREFORE:

In consideration of future services provided by Employee in the normal course and scope of his/her County employment, the County agrees to pay Employee a one-time, non-recurring hazard/incentive benefit of \$ 1,000.00 for full-time County employees and a one-time, non-recurring hazard/incentive benefit of \$500.00 to part-time County employees for the above stated reasons. The period of performance for the incentive pay will run concurrently with the employee's first normally scheduled payroll period that begins after execution of this agreement. The incentive pay will be issued on the same day as the employee's normal pay for said pay period, in consideration of the work performed during said pay period. (Said period of work shall include time worked after September 15, 2022, through the date payment is issued pursuant to this program.)

Clay County reserves the right to rescind this agreement and the Employee understands this agreement shall stand rescinded should it become apparent by guidance from U.S. Treasury or the Office of the Mississippi Attorney General that incentive pay, as contemplated by this

agreement, is or will be in violation of applicable constitutional provisions, federal law or state statute(s).
