NO CELLPHONES, PAGERS, OR OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES  
NO FOOD OR DRINKS IN THE COURT ROOM  
NO SAGGY PANTS  
NO SUNGLASSES  
NO INAPPROPRIATE UNDERGARMENTS

If You Are In Violation Of These DRESS CODES, You Will Not Enter The Court.

### CLAY COUNTY JUSTICE COURT GUIDELINES FOR COURT

- Please be on time for your attendance at the Justice Court, which is 9:00 am.
- Make sure you have on the appropriate clothing and undergarments.
- Please be respectful to the officers, staff and bailiffs of the court.
- When your name is called, say HERE OR PRESENT loud enough to be heard, and step forward to the podium for the disposition of your case.
- Please speak up loudly for the Judge to hear what you are saying,
- If you are represented by an attorney, you should have your attorney with you when your name is called.
- If you are a parent, you can step forward with your son or daughter.
- Do not place your hands in your pockets; keep them by your side.
- Make sure to address everyone in the courtroom with "YES SIR / MA'AM" and "NO SIR / MA'AM."
- Please do not interrupt the Judge, Attorney, or Prosecutor while they are speaking.
- You are not allowed to communicate with prisoners at any time during court.
- Please be mindful about bringing children to court.
